Holiday challenges for English learners

The goal of these challenges is for you to gain more **confidence** in speaking English and experience the wonderful feeling of **communicating** in the target language.

Start with the easier missions and then go on with the more challenging ones – believe me, you will feel more confident already after the first accomplished mission!



Some rules that you should bear in mind:

1. **Forget about your mobile phone**, especially Google Translator, Google Maps, your flashcards and co.
 2. If you want, **you can prepare with some useful phrases** to use – but mind you, once in the situation, you will concentrate more on making yourself understood than remembering the correct question word order (and this is all just fine!)
 3. **The goal is to accomplish the missions** – being grammatically correct is not the point here.
 4. Accomplished a mission? **Treat yourself!**
Accomplished all of them? **Celebrate!**
- +1. It is of course allowed to **make a mission several times** 😊

Simpler missions

For beginners

ACCOMPLISHED

1. Order a meal for you and your family / friends in a restaurant!
2. Ask the way to the nearest post office!
(You don't actually have to go there, just ask and try to figure out from the answer as much as you can.)
3. Ask the price of a product in a supermarket / shop!
4. Go to a bookshop and ask for a book from the shop assistant!
5. Think of a mission to accomplish:

More challenging missions

Level: A2-B1

ACCOMPLISHED

1. Book a table in a restaurant – personally or on the phone!
2. Ask the way to a local attraction!
(Make sure you understand the answer and try to find the place without a GPS – if necessary, ask another person too!)
3. Go to a market place and buy fruit and vegetables!
(Pointing at them is not allowed, talk!)
4. Go to a bookshop and ask the assistant what they would recommend for a 12-year-old boy (or your mom, or your daughter – you decide)!
5. Offer your help to somebody (e.g. an old lady with a heavy bag) and ask them at least one question!
6. Think of a mission to accomplish:

Top challenges

Level: B1+

ACCOMPLISHED

1. Reserve a daily trip (e.g. boat trip or guided tour) at your hotel or at an agency – ask questions about all the necessary information!
2. Start a conversation with somebody (e.g. while waiting in line or in a bar) and make small talk for at least 5 minutes!
3. Visit a tourist attraction and take part on a guided tour in English or ask for an English audio guide!
4. Talk in English for a whole day!
5. Think of a mission to accomplish:
